Russia - 100% Genuine leather binding material.

3/4 Bound - A binder with imitation leather covers and genuine leather backbone.

C&H Plastic - A binder made with high-impact ABS material and steel bindings.

Fly Sheets & End Sheets - Protective polyethylene sheets placed in every binder.

Bumper Back, Bounce Back, Safety Back - A rubber padded, imitation leather covered backbone found on some curved-back binders designed to absorb shock if dropped.

Post - Metal rod (rectangular or round) that holds sheets in binder.
Rectangular available in 5/16" and 7/16" width. Round available in 5/16" diameter.

Pulls - Sliding bars to release and lock the posts in position inside a binder.

Binding Edge - The side of the sheet that is punched for binding.

Line of Lettering - Refers to each impression required for imprinting a binder.

Ruled & Printed - Filler sheets or forms with specially printed lines and printed headings.

Sheets & Pages - A sheet is a single piece of paper. There are 2 pages to every sheet.

Angle Tab or Hinge Flap - See diagrams below.

Center to Center or C-C - The distance measured between the center of one post to the center of another. Measurement is required to determine hole or post spacing.

Outside Centers - Center to Center measurement of the two outermost posts on opposite ends of the metal. (See diagram below.)
